The purpose of this letter is to update you to a few changes that will occur at Camp Buffalo this summer. Some of these changes are a direct result of Scoutmaster Conferences held last year with you at Buffalo.

1. We will be taking our meals in the new dining hall.
2. The meal service staff has been changed.
3. Camp fees are \$185 for youth and \$85 for adults. All fees include t-shirts.
4. \$85 deposit with t-shirt order form by April 1 for youth.  
\$45 deposit with t-shirt order form by April 1 for adults.  
Balance due by May 9, 2008.
5. T-shirts will be ordered by information you provide. The cut-off date for correct size is April 1, 2008. If you do not order or order after April 1, you will receive a t-shirt but it may not be the size you want. There will be no exchanges at camp. On the order form, you will note that t-shirt sizes will be ordered by name. Please double check your shirt sizes once they are received to ensure they are the correct size(s). In other words, you will receive what you order. If you do not order by April 1 or if sizes are ordered wrong you will receive a t-shirt but it may not be the size desired.
6. **T-shirts will be available at the leader orientation meeting at Camp Buffalo starting at 6:00 Central/7:00 Eastern p.m., Tuesday June 10, 2008 with dinner provided.** Please RSVP by June 1 to let us know how many from your troop will be attending.

8. A new Ranger.
9. A much improved Operation First Class Area. (Brown Sea Island)
10. A new Camp Director.
